On The Green

Happening this month we will begin to do some much needed aerification on the Tee Tops and Greens. Tee tops will be done periodically throughout this month and the greens will be done on Monday, April 25th, and Tuesday, April 26th. We will be using the small 1/4 inch solid tines on the greens. The larger hollow tines will be used during the summer time.

We are trying to manage our golf cart traffic control with signs on the course. We prefer not to have signs all over, but players continually drive around tees and greens; and do not stay on the cart path. Please do your part and try your best to be on the "CART PATHS" when you are around TEES & GREENS. Thanks!

One more aerification procedure we will be starting this month is using our Airway Slicer on the fairways only. This machine slices and breaks up compacted areas. We mow right behind to clean up the excess debris.
